Introduction

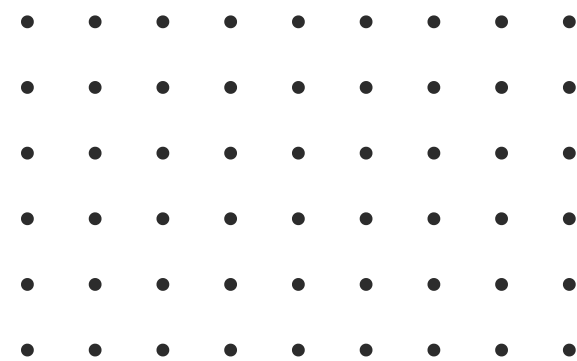
The session should take approximately 20 - 35 minutes.

I'd like to ask you just a few quick questions about yourself before we get started with completing a few tasks.

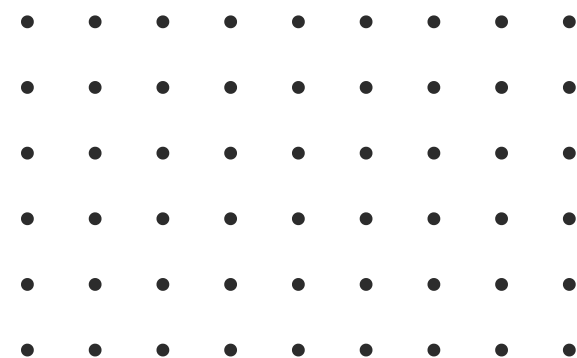


Interview Questions

1. Tell me a little bit about yourself?
2. Are you a student or teacher?
3. What are you studying or teaching?
4. How do you feel about learning something new?
5. How do you feel about online learning? Do you like it? Why or why not?

Testing Questions

1. Before we begin, take a few minutes to review the homepage. Tell me what the purpose of this site/app is?
2. What do you think you can gain from this site/app?
3. What tasks do you think you can accomplish using this site?



Direct Tasks

1. Where would you go to search for a subject?
2. Complete the onboarding steps 1-3
3. Sign-up and create your account
4. Search for a teacher you would like to learn from (how did you feel about selecting your time zone)
5. Request for a session with your chosen teacher. How did you feel about the session request form?
6. Send a message to your selected teacher. How did you feel about that process?
7. Where can you go to find your resources or help when you get confused or have a question?
